The question and the complete answer is as follows.

8. Do you need any special qualifications to be nominated as the "assessment manager" for a development application?

No. The assessment manager is the local government (unless a different entity is prescribed under a regulation) and the functions of an assessment manager can be delegated to any person who has the ability to coordinate the various processes applicable to the application.
