# **Building Newsflash**

# **Proposed Renumbering of the Queensland Development Code**

## **Purpose**

To advise of the proposed renumbering of the Queensland Development Code (QDC) and consequential update of the Building Codes Queensland (BCQ) website.

## **Background**

The QDC has been in operation for over five years, with new parts added to the list as they are approved. BCQ is proposing the addition of a new QDC part and amendments to several existing QDC parts (see Newsflash 284). After reviewing the QDC format, BCQ is proposing the organisation of the QDC into new categories, as well as the introduction of a new numbering system (see Attachment 1).

The rearrangement will ensure QDC parts are:

- o in a logical sequence according to their legislative status;
- o in readily identifiable categories according to their application; and
- o easily accessible by building and design industry professionals and the public.

## **Industry Comment**

#### Legislation

Building Act 1975 Building Regulation 2006 Acts Interpretation Act 1954

Acts such as the *Residential Services Accreditation Act 2002*, the *Child Care Act 2002* and the *Pastoral Workers' Accommodation Act 1980* refer to certain QDC parts. The renumbering of the QDC means the parts these Acts refer to will have a different number. This does <u>not</u> mean they no longer apply. The *Acts Interpretation Act 1954* has provisions to allow the original parts to continue to operate with the new numbers. Website notation of the original QDC number will help with referencing.
