



Plumbing Newsflash

Proposed changes to *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002* and other legislation

Purpose

The purpose of this Newsflash is to advise of workshop dates for industry training on the proposed changes to the *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002* and the introduction of a new Part of the Queensland Development Code (QDC).

Background

South-east Queensland (SEQ) is experiencing the effects of the worst drought on record. Despite recent moderate inflows from rain in August and September 2007, the combined level in the region's major water supply storages remains at an historic low. The *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002* has been amended to allow wider use of treated greywater, a new Part of the QDC has been drafted and other Parts have been amended to support water saving initiatives.

Also, changes to the Plumbing and Drainage Licensing System are proposed.

Workshops

Workshops to be conducted by the Plumber and Drainers Board and Master Plumbers Association of Queensland (MPAQ) have been arranged to provide an overview of the following:


- Greywater related changes;
- Water meters in multi unit and non-residential areas;
- Blackwater re-use trials in SEQ sewered areas;
- Licensed work on-site sewerage facilities; and
- Competence based licensing.


