Expressions of interest for Building Development and Dispute Resolution Committee Referees

Purpose

To seek expressions of interest from suitably qualified industry practitioners wishing to serve as general referees on the Building and Development Dispute Resolution Committee (Committee).

Background

The Committee is established under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* to hear appeals about a range of planning, building, plumbing and other related matters.

Expressions of interest

General referees must possess qualifications or experience necessary to hear and decide appeals against decisions made under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, *Building Act 1975*, *Residential Services (Accreditation) Act 2002* and the *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002*.

Successful candidates will be appointed as general referees for a term of three years for deployment on appeals as required from time to time. The frequency of appointment as a member of a Committee will depend on the type, number and origin of appeals received.

Remuneration will be paid in accordance with the government procedures for part-time Chairs and Members of Government Boards, Committees and Statutory Authorities. Remuneration is only paid to eligible general referees when appointed to a Committee established to consider a specific appeal.
