BCA Section J Brisbane seminar

Purpose

The purpose of this Newsflash is to advise that Australian Institute of Refrigeration Air Conditioning and Heating (AIRAH) will host a one day seminar in Brisbane on Wednesday 17 September 2008 on Section J of the Building Code of Australia (BCA).

Background

The one day seminar will provide an analysis and open discussion of the energy efficiency requirements of BCA Section J along with a summary of the verification requirements.

Australian standards related to Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) designs will also be analysed to determine their impact on energy efficiency.

Two prominent environmental rating tools used in today's non residential market, the National Australian Building Environment Rating System and Green Star will be appraised to identify their impact on energy efficient HVAC designs.
