

Building Newsflash

Assessment of building work in an erosion prone area or seaward of a coastal building line

Purpose

This newsflash provides information on the role of building certifiers in the assessment of development applications involving building work in an erosion prone area and/or on land completely or partly seaward of a coastal building line.

Background

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has developed an information sheet for the assessment of building work in an erosion prone area or seaward of a coastal building line. This information sheet can be accessed from the following web page www.epa.qld.gov.au/ecoaccess.

To accommodate this roll-in the Integrated Development Assessment System (IDAS) Application Form 1 has been amended by the inclusion of a new <u>Part M</u> entitled *Operational work in tidal areas and in coastal management districts* and a new version of the <u>Referrals Checklist (Version 7.0)</u>.

<u>Guide 18</u> Does my application involve assessment of coastal development? has also been prepared to accommodate this roll-in.

The roll-in of approvals under the *Coastal Protection and Management Act 1995* into the *Integrated Planning Act 1997* (IPA) and IDAS framework commenced on Monday 20 October 2003.
