Plumbing sessions—Information sessions delivered by Plumbing Industry Council staff will be conducted in partnership with local government plumbing inspectors. The sessions are aimed at local plumbers providing an opportunity for license holders to discuss recent changes to plumbing legislation and their legislative obligations. Sessions will cover:

- phase out of electric hot water systems 2010
- new licence endorsement-solar and heat pump water system installations
- establishment of the new Plumbing Industry Council
- general observations, an update on investigations and licence requirements.

Plumbing Industry Council investigators will provide on overview of recent compliance activities and the Master Plumber's Association of Queensland will provide a short presentation on the courses they offer for gaining a license endorsement to install, commission, test and maintain solar and heat pump hot water systems (newsflash 390).
