Minor and machinery in nature	The following proposals are machinery in nature and do not result in substantive changes to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government or the community:
	 Amendment of references to LGIAsuper and LGIAsuper Trustee in the LGA to Brighter Super and Brighter Super Trustee respectively, in response to a recent change of name of the local government superannuation trustee and consequential minor amendments in the SSPSA and SPEPR.
Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	The following proposal is deregulatory (removes regulation) and does not increase costs or regulatory burden on business or the community:
	 Removing the requirement for permanent local government employees, other than those in defined benefit schemes, to make a personal contribution at a legislated rate into their superannuation account.
